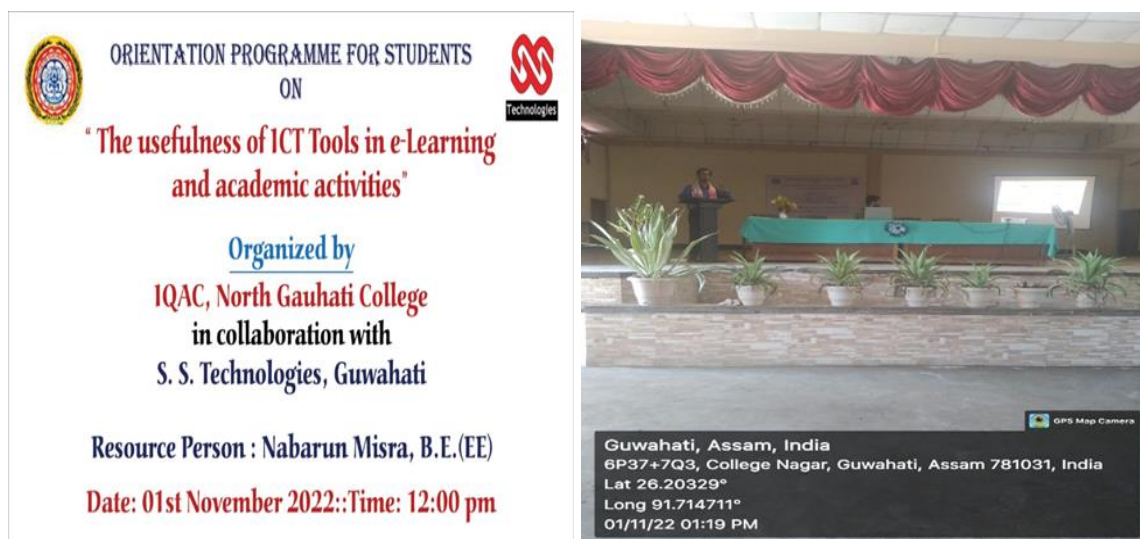

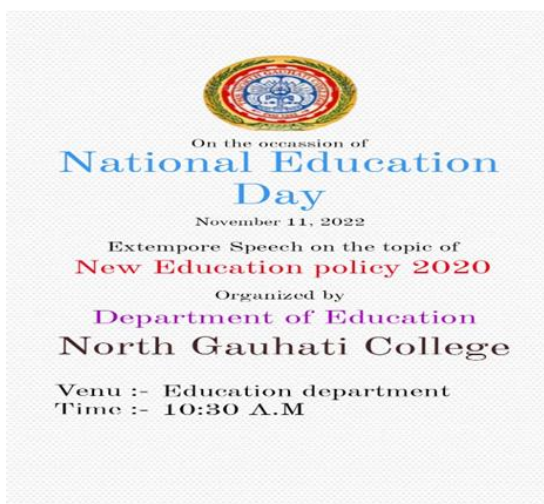

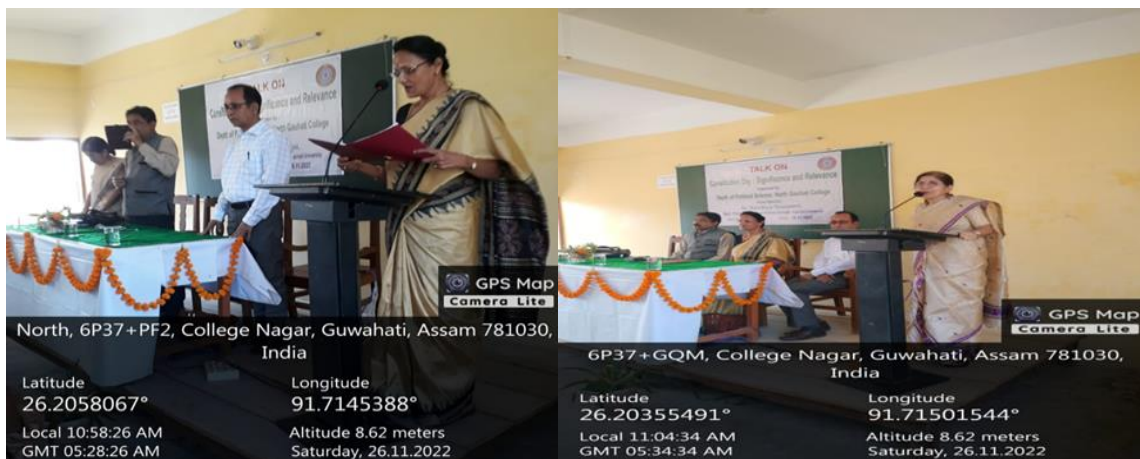


10. Observance of 9th Constitution Day (26.11.2022)

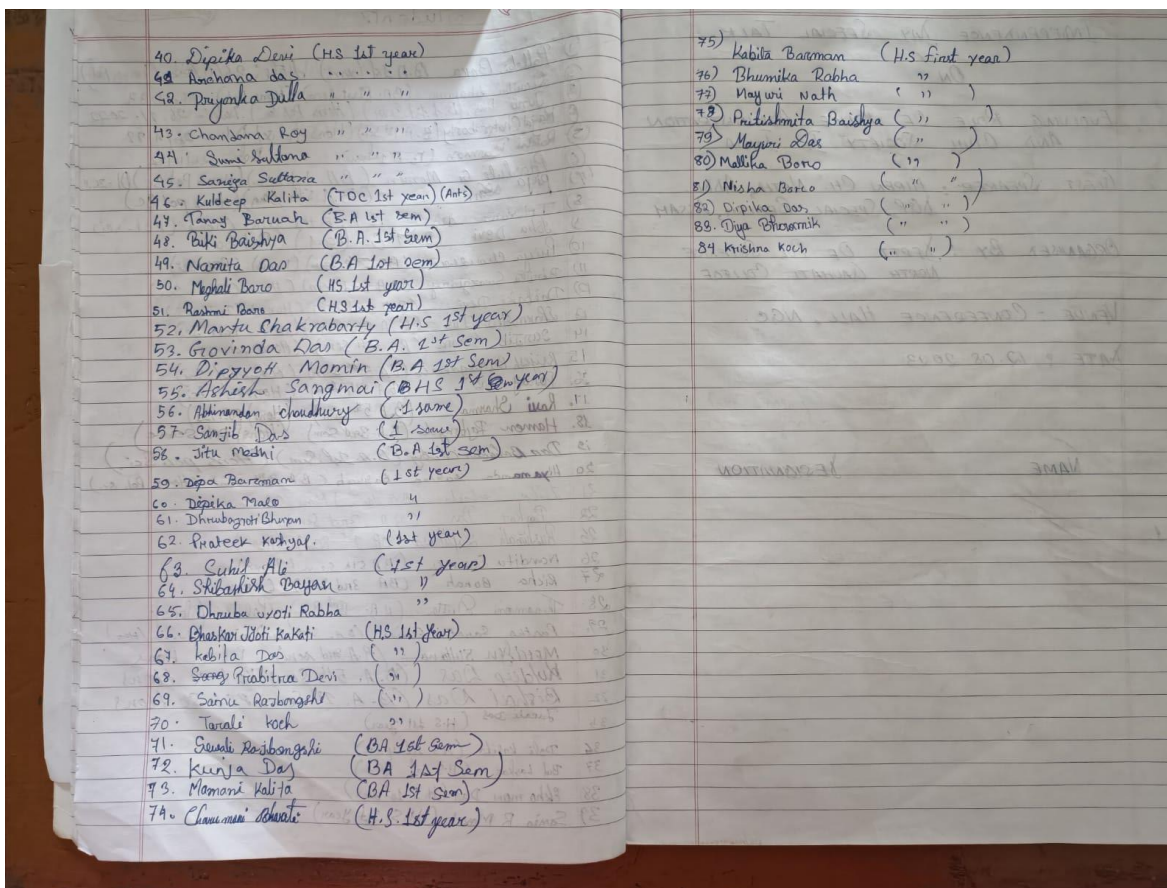

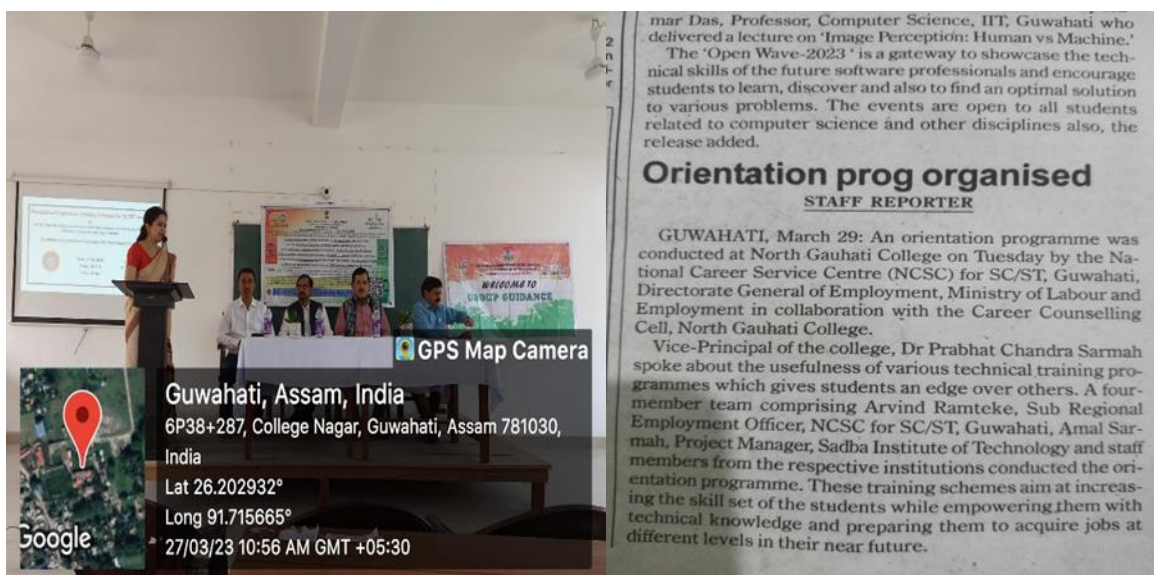

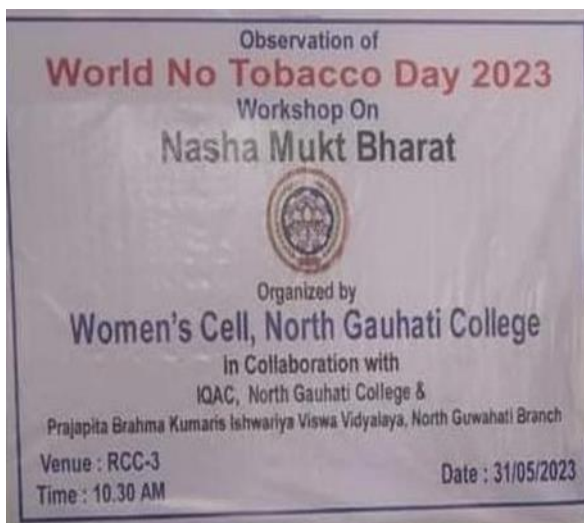

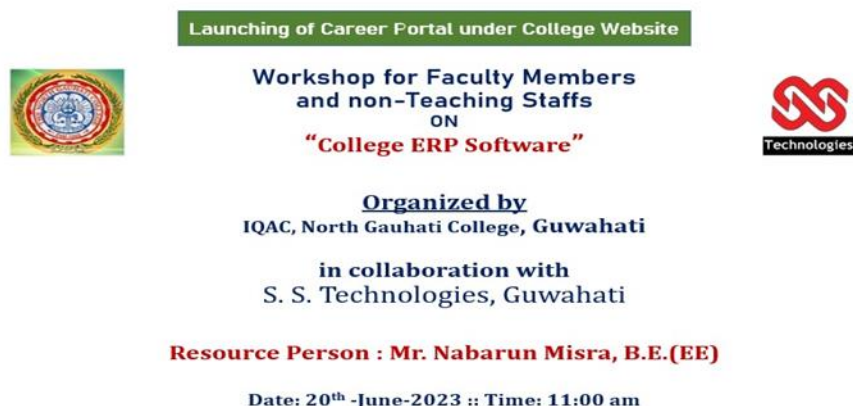

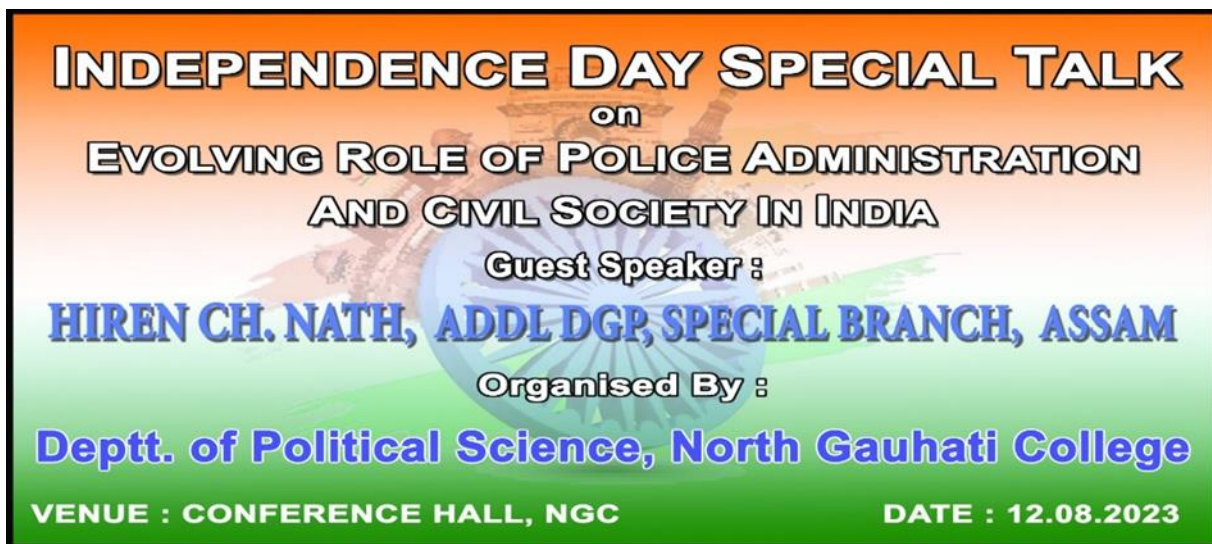

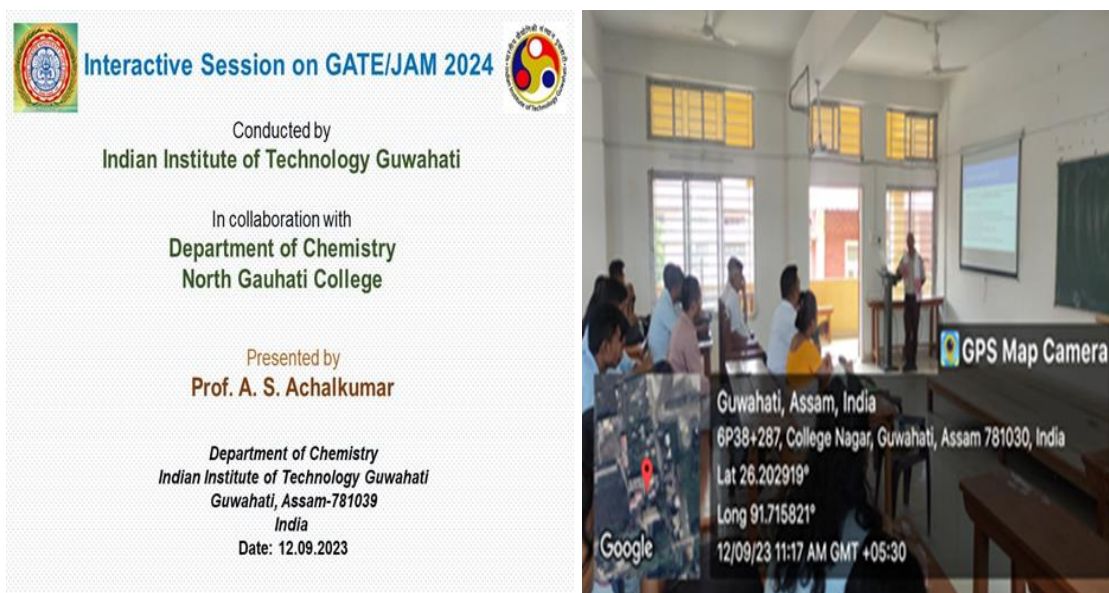

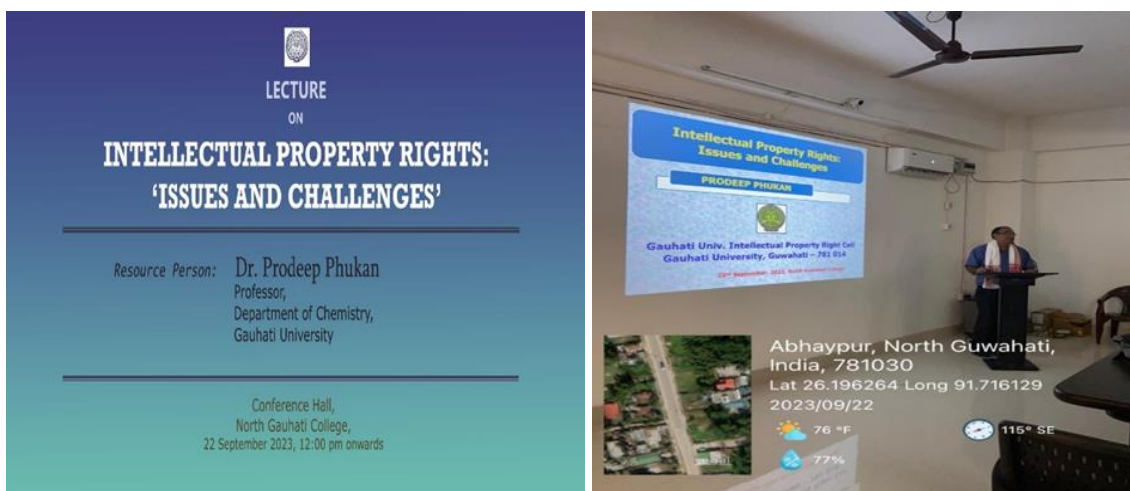

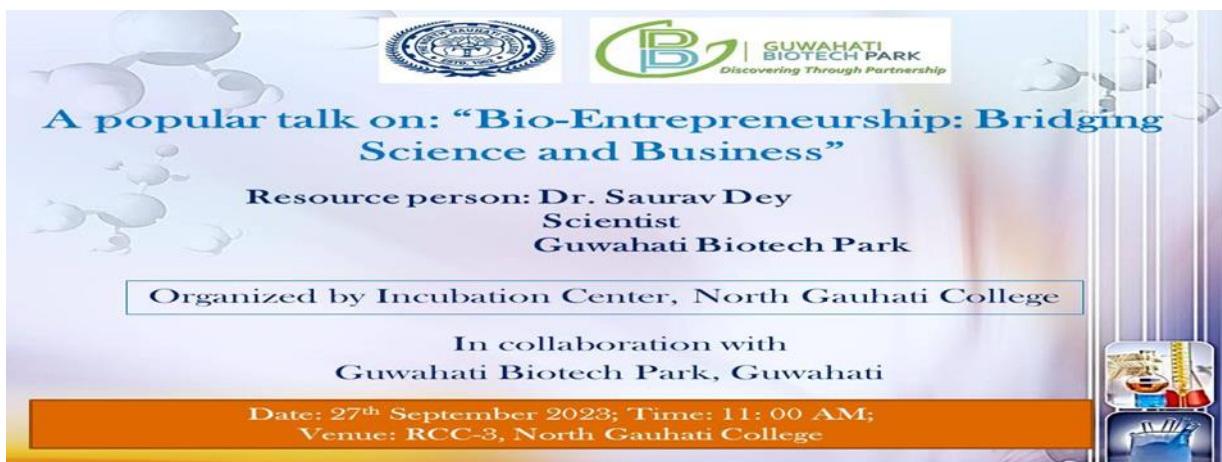




34. Awareness Programme on "Good Samaritan Law and Road Traffic Accident" (11.11.2023)

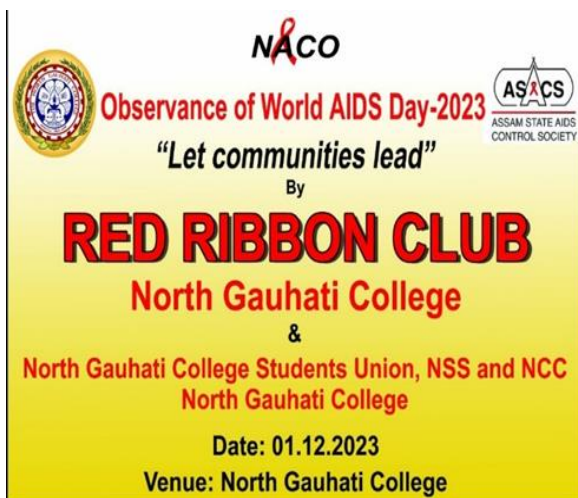

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3. Report on Two-Days Awareness & Skill Enhancement Programme on Plastic Technology (18.02.2020-19.02.2020)

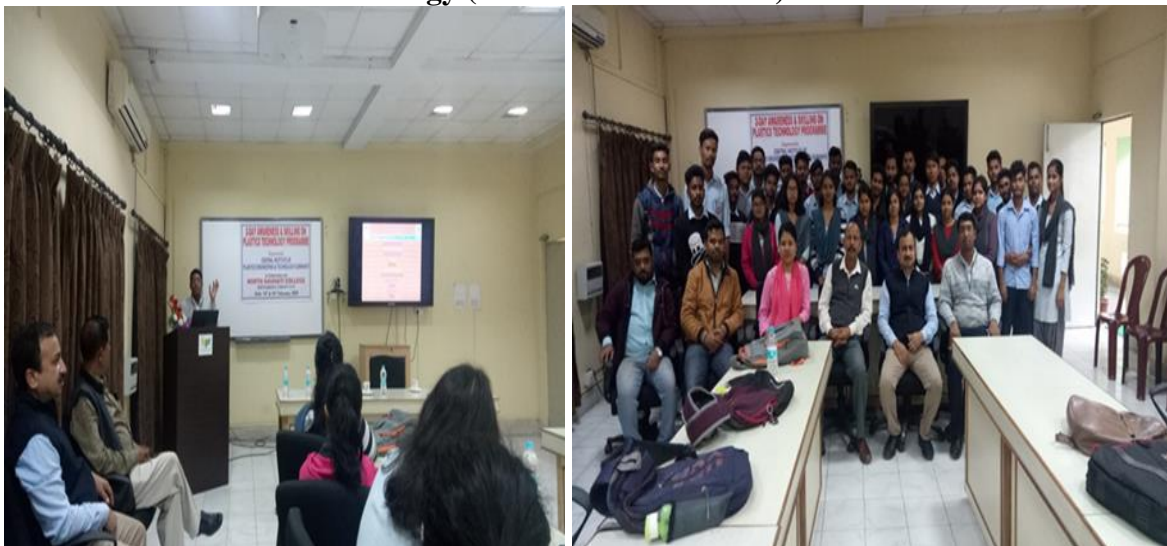
