




10. Observance of 9th Constitution Day (26.11.2022)






34. Awareness Programme on "Good Samaritan Law and Road Traffic Accident" (11.11.2023)




5. Webinar on IPR (29.10.2021)




7. Talk on Oral History (26.11.2021)







8. Lecture on Career Opportunities (30.12.2021)








9. Workshop on Mushroom Cultivation (04.01.2022)




8. 1 Day Workshop – IPR (17.04.2021)


