Event details:

An industry connect bootcamp on “Model Smart AIoT Systems” was organised by NIELIT, Guwahati at North Gauhati College supported by Kaidoko Automation Solutions Private Limited during February 17 - February 21, 2025. The event duration was 30 hours in total including classroom lectures and assignments to participants spread over a duration of 5 (five) days. A total of 50 undergraduate students from both Arts and Science backgrounds registered for the event with 70% students belonging to the Scheduled Caste (SC) category, which was also a prerequisite for the program batch. In addition, 7 (seven) un-registered students also completed the event bringing the final number of participants to 57 (fifty-seven).

The event was inaugurated on February 21, 2025 in presence of Dr. Bhaskar Jyoti Hazarika, Principal, North Gauhati College, Mr. Pradip Kumar Kalita, Academic Coordinator, Mr. Anupam Thakuria, Chairperson of the Committee, Dr. Gautam Saikia and Dr. Saurav Kalita, Coordinators of the event and the two resource persons from NIELIT, Guwahati.

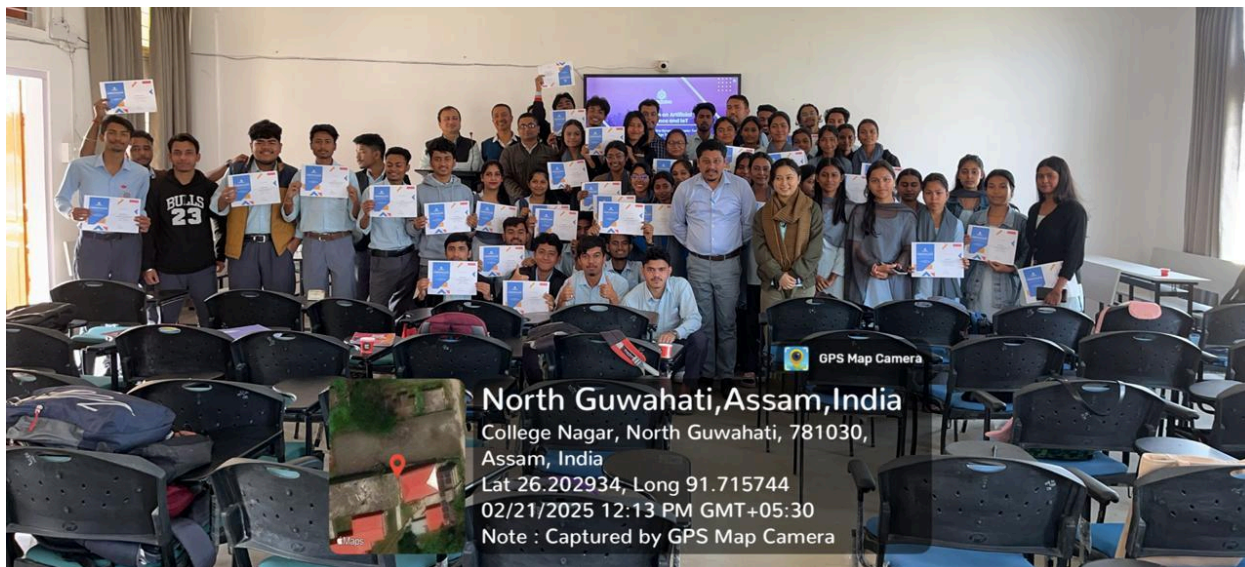


The resource persons from NIELIT, Guwahati Mr. Apurba Dey and Miss Nuncy Phanjom conducted the bootcamp training for all five days which included practical demonstrations and explanations of key concepts related to Artificial Intelligence (AI) and Internet of Things (IoT). The resource persons used real world examples of trending topics to involve the participants in conversation making it a very interesting and fruitful experience for everyone. There was a lot of positive interaction during the event which reflected during the feedback session at the end.



The event came to an end on February 21, 2025 with an Assessment Exam conducted for the participants followed by a Feedback and Felicitation ceremony. The certificates were distributed to all participants who had cleared the Assessment test while also taking their daily attendance during the event into consideration. The Principal, North Gauhati College, the Academic Coordinator, Chairperson of the Committee, Coordinators of the event, both the resources persons, and a few of the participants shared their experience during the five day event. Overall, the event was a success with the participating students showing enthusiasm and eagerness towards attending more such events in the near future.
