

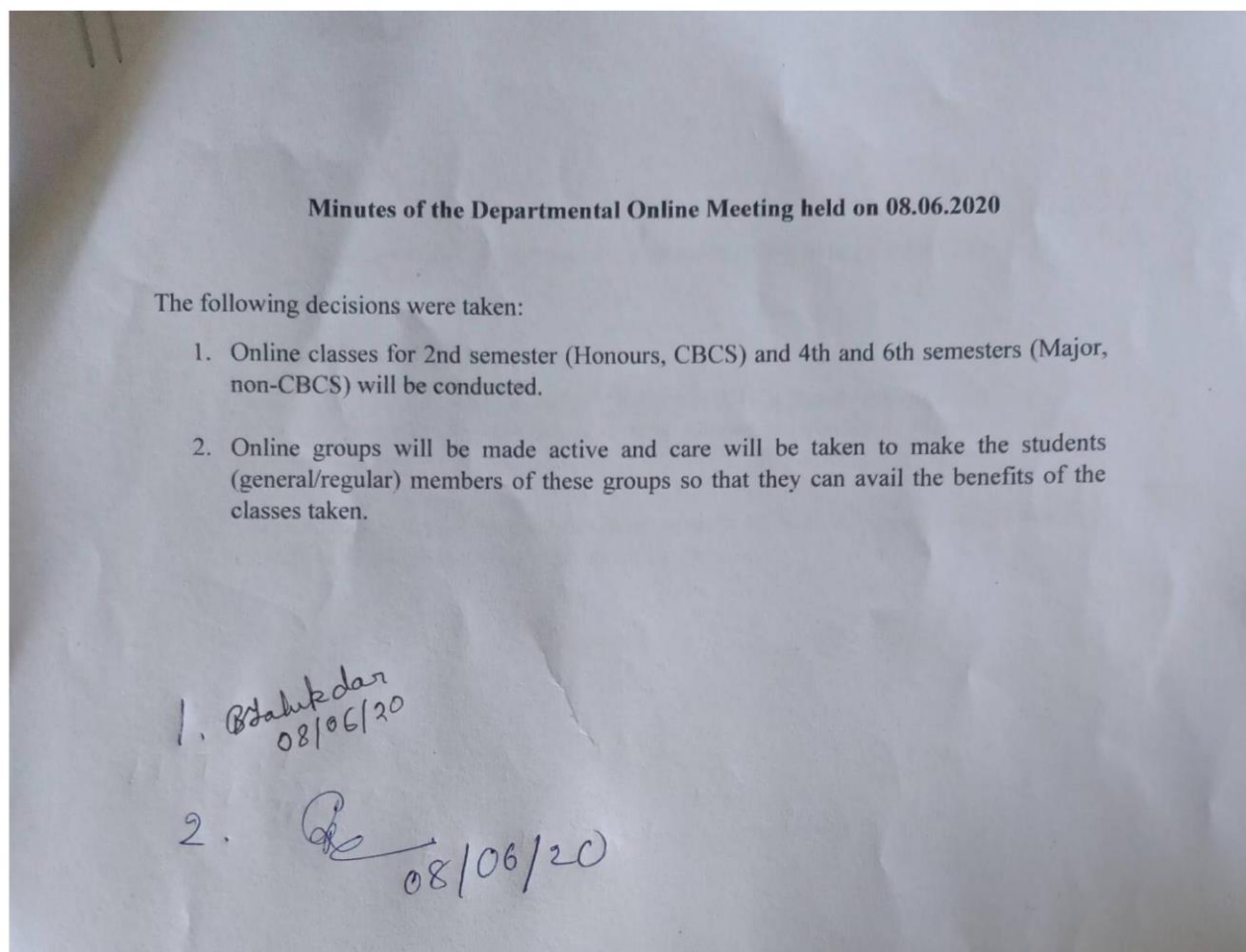
As a sample, we have shown here the curricular activities done by the Political Science department of the college. The remaining departments also carried out the similar curriculum activities.

1. Record of Departmental Meetings:

The outbreak of Covid-19 and the lockdown which followed thereafter changed the whole teaching-learning scenario. We had to change our method of teaching from the traditional mode to the online mode which put the students in a challenging situation, given the fact that they were deficient in terms of availability of network and devices, as most of them belong to the lower economic stratum. Hence, the two faculty members present in the department had to meet very frequently over different platforms like whatsapp and telephonic communication to discuss on how to make the students adapt to the new environment and give them the greater benefit of teaching and those communications are recorded here as minutes of departmental meetings.

Even after reopening of educational institutions on 23.09.2020, we had to frequently change our strategy regarding teaching and examinations, due to the Covid-19 specific government SOP's.

Minutes of the Departmental Meeting held on 23.09.2020:

The two faculty members sat together and discussed about the workload and expressed concern regarding the completion of the syllabus in offline mode as two faculty members are not sufficient. A detailed discussion was made on course, class distribution and departmental routines.


Minutes of the Departmental Meeting held on 03.12.2020:

An International Webinar on 'Indo-Nepal Relations in current Socio-Political Context' was organized by the Department of Political Science, North Gauhati College in association with IQAC, North Gauhati College and ICT Academy on 1st October, 2020. The Webinar was inaugurated by Dr Dilip Das, the Principal of North Gauhati College with his welcome address. The Resource Person of the Webinar was Dr Chandra Upadhyay, HOD, Department of Sociology, Mahendra Morang Adarsh Multiple Campus of Tribhuban University, Nepal. The introduction of the Resource person was given by Dr Banima Talukdar, HOD, Department of Political Science, North Gauhati College. In his speech the Resource Person gave stress on the relation of Nepal with India from various angles. Nepal is in the middle of India's Himalayan frontiers and along with Bhutan it acts as Northern border flanks and also acts as buffer state against any possible aggression from China. He said that recently it is seen the establishment of diplomatic relations between Nepal and China, and China's growing influence in Nepal has resulted in declining traditional leverage of India in Nepal, and it has led a little bit of confusion on relation in between India and Nepal. 



