- ✓ The article should be an original contribution and in English.
- ✓ The length of the paper, inclusive of references, should not exceed 3000 words.
- ✓ The paper should be neatly typed in Word format with standard margin of 1 inch on all sides.
- ✓ Font– Times New Roman, size- 12, with 1.5 line spacing.
- ✓ Title should be concise, in bold letters, size-14.
- ✓ The author details including name, designation and affiliation should be typed after the title of the article and should include email address. An asterisk (*) must be placed after the corresponding author's name.
- The abstract should be within 300 words with at least four keywords.
- ✓ Graphs, figures, photos and tables should be placed in the text wherever they are discussed in the paper.
- ✓ For reference style, APA format, 7th edition to be adopted.
- ✓ If there are explanatory notes or references, they should be included as endnotes with serial numbers.
- ✓ Plagiarism of any type to be strictly avoided.
- ✓ The author(s) will be informed about the acceptance after the review process is over.
- ✓ A processing fee of Rs. 1000/- per article is to be deposited by the author only after the acceptance of the research article.
