AZIM PREMJI SCHOLARSHIP

Annual Scholarship of ₹30,000 for Girls

The Azim Premji Scholarship Program is a commitment to support girl students from disadvantaged background to pursue their college education.

SCHOLARSHIP

- ₹30,000 per year that can be used for tuition fees or any other education-related expenses
- Awarded for the full duration of the first undergraduate degree or diploma course

ELIGIBILITY

- Passed **both Class 10 and Class 12** as a **regular student** from a **government school or college** in any of the **eligible States or Union Territories***.
- Have taken **admission in the first year** (for academic session 2026–27) as a **regular student** of a recognized **undergraduate degree or diploma course** (2 to 5 years duration) at a **government** or a (credible and bona fide) **private college or university, anywhere in India**.

STATES & UNION TERRITORIES*

Andhra Pradesh, Arunachal Pradesh, Assam, Bihar, Chhattisgarh, Delhi (NCT), Jharkhand, Karnataka, Madhya Pradesh, Manipur, Meghalaya, Mizoram, Nagaland, Odisha, Puducherry, Rajasthan, Sikkim, Telangana, Tripura, Uttar Pradesh, and Uttarakhand.

APPLICATION WINDOW

Round 1: August 10th, 2026 to August 31st, 2026

Round 2: January 10th, 2027 to January 31st, 2027

There is no fee for applying. All applications will be accepted online through our website only.

DOCUMENTS REQUIRED

All applicants must submit clear, coloured, and unedited soft copies of their:

- 1) Passport-size photo (plain background, taken in last 6 months)
- 2) Aadhaar Card
- 3) Bank account details (any one):
 - Passbook, or
 - Account statement of the last one month
- 4) Class 10 original marksheet
- 5) Class 12 original marksheet
- 6) Proof of admission (any one):
 - Bona fide Certificate, or
 - Tuition Fee Receipt

Note: All soft copies should be in PDF/JPG/PNG format between 30KB and 500KB file size.
